Draught Bass – 3.6% Pint 1/2 Pint
 £2.80 £1.40
 Legendary English Ale, brewed in Burton-on-Trent since 1777. Bass Red Triangle Iconic first registered trademark in the U.K. Still brewed to original recipe

Becks Vier – 4.0% £2.80 £1.40
 Vier – 4 in German – refers to its 'ABV' and the four ingredients – pure glacier water, golden barley, Bavarian hops and its unique yeast. Brewed in Bremen, Germany

Staroprager – 5% £3.00 £1.50
 The favourite beer of Prague since 1869. Brewed in the Czech republic – bohemian barley and malty tastes – quenching with a bitter finish

Heineken Premium – 5% £3.20 £1.60
 Superb Continental imported lager – Europe's No. 1 Premium 5%

Krombacher Pils – 4.8% £3.20 £1.60
 The number one premium beer in Germany. The taste of Pilsener characterised by fresh, pure mineral water

Cruzcampo – 5% £3.20 £1.60
 Classic Cerveza of Andalucia, brewed in Spain, typical light tasting with a fine balance of malt and hops

Guinness Draught – 4.1% £2.80 £1.40
 Classic Irish stout

Thatchers Cider – 4.5% £2.80 £1.40
 Made in Somerset for over 100 years, traditional cider matured in oak

Corona – 4.6% - Mexico - 330 ml £2.70
 Typical American style lager with lingering hops on the finish

Peroni – 5.2% - Italy - 330 ml £2.70
 Nastro-Azzuro (Blue Ribbon) from Rome – fruity, hoppy aroma

Leffe Blonde - 6.6% - Belgium - 330 ml £3.00
 Classic Abbey beer with hints of quince, gooseberries, cloves and nuts

Grolsch Swing Top – 5% - 450 ml £3.50
 Dutch premium since 1615 from the green light district!

BOTTLED CIDERS

Westons Premium Organic Cider – 6.5% - Herefordshire - 50 cl £3.50
 From 'Much Marcle' Herefordshire since 1878, made from organic cider apples matured in oak vats

Kopparberg Pear Cider - 4.5% - Sweden - 50cl £3.00
 From Kopparberg in Sweden semi sweet from original 1930 recipe, the Worlds best selling pear cider naturally fermented to 4.5% ABV

SPIRITS WHISKY

Baillie Nicol Jarvie – 40% - Scotland 25ml 50ml
 £2.00 £3.50
 BNJ was inspired by, and created in honour of a notable character immortalised in the pages of Sir Walter Scott's epic 'Rob Roy'

MALT WHISKY

Glenmorangie 10 Year Old - 40% - Speyside, Scotland £2.50 £4.50
 This rare expression highland malt, it's final maturation – the perfect 10 – 10 years in ex-Bourbon casks

Ardbeg Islay 10 Year Old – 46% - Scotland £2.50 £4.50
 Non chill filtered with strength of 46% ABV which retains maximum flavour. Smokey sweetness, peaty style with aroma of medicinal phenols

IRISH WHISKY

Blackbush – 40% - Ireland £2.00 £3.50
 Originally called 'Uisee Beatha' which is Irish for 'Water of life'. Bushmills distillery is the oldest licensed Whisky distillery in the World

BOURBON

Jack Daniels Tennessee Whisky £2.00 £3.50
 The story started in 1866 when a 17 year old named Jack Daniels set up a distillery outside Lynchburg, Tennessee

GIN

Bombay Sapphire – 40% - London Dry Gin £2.00 £3.50
 The selection and balance of Bombay Sapphires botanicals is based on a recipe dating from 1761

Tanqueray No. Ten – 47.3% - London £2.50 £4.50
 Gin first distilled in Holland in the 1600's using a recipe created by Franciscus de la Boe – a legendary physician and professor

VODKA

Skyv Vodka – 40% - USA £2.00 £3.50
 Started way back in 1992 in San Francisco. Quadruple distilled and triple filtered for an extremely smooth taste

Belvedere Vodka – 40% - Poland £2.50 £4.50
 Poland is widely recognised as the birthplace of vodka, Belvedere Palace was formerly the home of Polish Royalty – distilled 4 times

Grey Goose Vodka – 40% - France £3.00 5.50
 From the Cognac region of Western France – the Worlds best tasting Vodka

RUM

Bacardi – 37.5% - Bahamas £2.00 £3.50
 The whitest of all aged rum and the most aged of all white rum – vanilla and cherries, a perfect mix

Ten Cane Rum – 40% - Trinidad £3.00 £5.50
 First pressing cane juice doubly distilled in small Cognac style stills

Hennessy Fine de Cognac - 40% - France £3.00 £5.50
 Established in 1765 by Richard Hennessy who was an Irishman. The master blender 'Yann Fillioux' is the 7th generation of the Fillioux family of past master blenders which keeps the tradition alive

Hine Antique – 40% - France £6.00 £10.00
 Thomas Hine from Dorset married a young French maid who took over her fathers Cognac house in Jarnac. Antique XO is Hines flagship first blended in 1920

Luxardo Sambuca – 38% - Italy 25ml £2.00
 The Italian aniseed flavoured liqueur. Serve ammazza café, coffee killer after the coffee to dull its taste

Luxardo Passione Nera Black Sambuca – 38% - Italy £2.00
 Pure Italian style of Sambuca and Liqueurice

Jagermeister – 35% - Germany £2.00
 German for Master Hunjen, a blend of many herbs including liqueurice – a herd liqueur rather than a bitter

Jose Cuervo Tequilla Gold – 38% - Mexico £2.00
 Gets its distinctive colour and mellow taste from aging in oak

Tia Maria – 26.5% - West Indies £2.00
 Made with Jamaican Blue Mountain coffee beans
